AWARDS AND PRIZES CONDITIONS

These regulations detail the awards and prize funds for the Michelin Power Cup, Michelin Endurance Challenge Cup, Junior TAG Endurance, National Endurance and MotoGrande Championships in 2010.

1 ANNOUNCEMENT

The Hottrax Motorsport will host the above Championships following the confirmed calendar attached to this document. The document is referred to as 2010 CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS. All Championships will be awarded with points and trophies for the top 3 in each class. Awards are subject to sufficient entries being received before the closing date for the event details are shown below.

Michelin Tyre Company PLC will be awarding cash, prizes and trophies.
Hottrax Motorsport will be awarding cash and trophies.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

Points are awarded to the top 15 in each and every Championship class as per the following at each round (Excluding Michelin Challenge Cup). The rider or team with the most points at the end of the year will be the winner of the Championship followed by all other finishers in points order. In the event of a tie both a count back of the most wins, then seconds and thirds etc will be used to award points.

Points are awarded as follows:

1st-25 points, 2nd-20 points, 3rd-16 points, 4th-13 points, 5th-11 points, 6th-10 points, 7th-9 points, 8th-8 points, 9th-7 points, 10th-6 points, 11th-5 points, 12th-4 points, 13th-3 points, 14th-2 points, 15th-1 point.

Michelin Endurance and MotoGrande Challenge Cup Points are awarded to the top 7 places as follows:

1st-10 points, 2nd-7 points, 3rd-5 points, 4th-4 points, 5th-3 points, 6th-2 points, 7th-1 point

Points may be reduced if full race distances cannot be run; the clerk of the course has the final decision.

3. PRIZES AND AWARDS

Trophies at each round are awarded to individuals in the MotoGrande and Michelin Power Cup and to teams in Junior and National Endurance. Each member of the team whether it is 2 or 3 riders will be awarded a trophy. Trophies are only awarded to teams and individuals who have entered on or before the closing date of the event.

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each of the Championships and Classes during 2010 subject to entries. There must be 1 or more entries in each class for trophies to be awarded. The entries must be received before the closing date of the event. If no entries are received for a class on or before the closing date then the event will not be run and no trophies or points will be awarded.

Trophies at the awards ceremony will be awarded to the team and team members individually up to a maximum as follows:

Trophies Awarded At Each Round

Michelin Power Cup:	Top 3 in each class, Individual Trophies
Junior TAG Endurance:	Top 3 in each class, Individual Trophies up to a maximum of 2 per team
National Endurance:	Top 3 in each class, Individual Trophies up to a maximum of 2 per Masters format and 3 per National format

Trophies Awarded For Final Championship

MotoGrande:	Top 3 in each class, Individual Trophies
Michelin Power Cup:	Top 3 in each class, Individual Trophies
Junior TAG Endurance:	Top 3 in each class, Individual Trophies up to a maximum of 2 per team
National Endurance:	Top 3 in each class, Individual Trophies up to a maximum of 2 per Masters format teams and 3 per National format teams
Michelin Challenge Cup:	Junior and National Endurance combined, top 3 teams overall running Michelin Tyres, Team Trophy MotoGrande , top 3 riders in each class running Michelin Tyres and an individual Trophy

4. MICHELIN CHALLENGE CUP AWARDS

Michelin Tyre Company PLC have agreed to sponsor and support Hottrax Motorsport for 3 years from 2010 onwards. We have put a package together for all Championships and Classes in 2010 as well as the new Michelin Power Cup Championship.

Various other sponsors are involved and will be providing services, prizes, vouchers and cash over the course of the year and at the end of the year.

- Teams and riders must use designated Michelin tyres at all times during the meeting to qualify for awards.
- Teams and riders must register with Biketek Mobile no later than before the start of the second meeting of 2010
- Teams and riders must compete in a minimum of Six rounds during 2010
- Teams and riders must run Michelin tyres in Six races to be eligible
- Teams and riders must run all bikes competing on Michelin tyres
- Tyres can be purchased at outlet of the teams or riders choice

Prize awarded to highest three overall point scoring (registered) Michelin running teams (Not class championship position)

The prize fund is shown below for 2010 and covers all of our Championships.

Endurance 600 and 1000 Championship Final Positions

Teams must use Michelin Tyres at all times during the meeting

All Endurance Championships and Classes are combined

1st place - £750 *, 2nd place - £500, 3rd place - £350. * An extra £250 is paid if the 1st place team win their class.

MotoGrande 600 and 1000 Sprint Championship Final Positions

Riders must use Michelin Tyres at all times during the meeting

Cash prizes are for 600cc and 1000cc classes

1st place - £200, 2nd place - £125, 3rd place - £75

5. MICHELIN POWER CUP

Power Cup 600 and 1000 Championship

Riders must use Michelin Tyres at all times during the meeting

Trophies are awarded as per previously stated

Prizes and prize money is awarded to the riders finishing in the top 3 of each class over all 3 of the races run at the meeting and not individual races.

Prize money is presented at each meeting to the top 3 in each class.

(Except for wild card entries)

1st place - £250, 2nd place - £150, 3rd place - £100 (per meeting)

Please see the attached prize matrix for details of other awards.

Trophies will be awarded at the current round.

6. OTHER AWARD AND PRIZE CONDITIONS

- Riders must attend podium ceremonies at the meeting when required. Failure to attend means trophies, awards, cash, product or vouchers will not be presented.
- Awards are not presented after the meeting or podium ceremony. Michelin Power Cup is an exception to this rule where awards for overall meeting performance is presented at the next round
- All Championship awards and prizes will be presented at the Hottrax Motorsport annual awards ceremony. Riders and teams must attend this ceremony to receive awards. Non attendance means awards are not presented at all.
- The date and venue of the awards ceremony is to be confirmed.
- Any specific terms applied by Hottrax, Michelin or other sponsors must be adhered to such as wearing hats on the podium, clothing, stickers or patches must be applied in the correct places and worn at the correct times.
- Michelin Tyres PLC are responsible for all prizes on offer apart from the cash and trophies
- Single event points are awarded to all competing riders including Wild Card riders.

7. WILD CARD RIDERS – MICHELIN POWER CUP

- Wild card riders may enter the Michelin Power Cup for one or more events at the normal entry fee of £330 per event. (Registered riders may enter at a cost of £220 per event)
- Wild card riders are able to have access to the hospitality available at the end of the racing on Saturday. Wild card riders may register at any time during the year at the normal cost of £350. At this point they will receive all of the benefits normally issued to riders. This cannot be backdated to previous events. They then become registered riders and are eligible to pay £220 entry fees.
- Wild card riders are not eligible for power pack items unless agreed in advance
- Wild card riders in the Michelin Power Cup will qualify for individual event points and trophies but not prize money or any sponsored product. Wild card entries are not eligible for any overall Championship prizes including cash, points or product. They are eligible for Championship Trophies.
- In the event that a wild card rider finishes in the top 3 over the 3 races then the prize money and other product prizes will be awarded to the rider finishing next in the results.
